



50 YEAR-OLD FEMALE WITH LAPAROSCOPIC CHOLECYSTECTOMY 10/20/10, NOW WITH EPIGASTRIC PAIN, NAUSEA/VOMITING AND SMALL FLUID COLLECTION IN THE GALLBLADDER FOSSA ON ULTRASOUND. CONCERN FOR BILE LEAK.

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**FINDINGS:**

ANTERIOR ABDOMINAL IMAGES OVER 60 MINUTES DEMONSTRATE DELAYED CLEARANCE OF TC 99M CHOLETEC FROM THE BLOOD POOL INDICATING SLIGHTLY IMPAIRED HEPATIC FUNCTION. THERE IS NO SMALL BOWEL ACTIVITY OR EVIDENCE OF BILE LEAK.

AT FOUR HOURS, MILD UPTAKE IN THE SMALL BOWEL IS NOTED. FINDINGS ARE COMPATIBLE WITH PARTIAL HIGH GRADE COMMON BILE DUCT OBSTRUCTION. THERE IS NO EVIDENCE FOR COMPLETE COMMON BILE DUCT OBSTRUCTION. ON DELAYED IMAGES THERE IS NO EVIDENCE OF BILE LEAK.

**IMPRESSION:**

FINDINGS CONSISTENT WITH PARTIAL HIGH GRADE COMMON BILE DUCT OBSTRUCTION. NO EVIDENCE OF BILE LEAK.

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
